## *From humble beginnings....*



In our last newsletter we broke the exciting news about the launch of King of Kings Ministries. We began in early December by holding daily prayer meetings. Finding buildings to rent is not easy but we knew we just needed to find somewhere and begin and God would lead us step by step. The only place we could find was what I can only describe as a very old, lopsided, long wooden shed type structure with a mud floor. With Christmas just around the corner we were reminded that if The King of Kings could be born in a stable then King of Kings Ministries could begin in a shed!!

Without any advertising people began to join Silas and I. As we gathered we felt God's presence in our midst and we saw His transforming power at work. Many of those God sent to us were hurting, needy people but with a heart to see God do a mighty work in that area of the town. God did many miracles, we saw burdens lifted, marriages restored, people found jobs and many were healed and delivered.

The numbers continued to increase and we began holding Sunday services, soon the little wooden structure became too small and we had to extend it. With only tarpaulins as a roof over the extended part the rains often poured in but everyone remained undeterred.

## *From strength to strength...*

As I said, it is very hard to find venues to rent but we managed to find one. Although the main meeting hall was on the small side it had lots of other advantages such as rooms to hold Junior Church and other rooms for offices and storage so we decided to apply. The building belonged to the Local Government and the process to rent it was very long and bureaucratic. But on February 5<sup>th</sup>, King of Kings Church moved to the new venue. The buildings themselves had been neglected for years and needed much renovation. As God would have it, our good friend and member of our Apostolic Oversight, Dr Gavin Williams had come from Australia with two friends to conduct training seminars for Pastors. They gave a week of their time and financial resources to help make over the buildings together with members of the Church. It's amazing what a few coats of paint can do!



## *A few challenges along the way!!*

We have truly seen God do great things as we have stepped out in faith to establish King of Kings Ministries but we have also been aware of a great spiritual battle around us. A few weeks ago Silas and two church members were driving home in the early hours of the morning having spent the night in prayer when they were stopped by three armed robbers. They stole money, phones and other valuable equipment from the car but fortunately, after threatening them at gun point for several hours, left them unharmed. Thank you for all those who prayed for us, we praise God all three recovered from the fear and trauma of the event. Life in Uganda is highly volatile, certainly vulnerable and often totally unpredictable. We would humbly ask you to pray for us more than ever especially for God's protection in around our lives.

## From glory to glory.....

Much to our joy, on our first Sunday in the new building the church was full and it has remained this way ever since. This left us with an interesting challenge. Last week we started two new services and Kings Kids Junior Church! One thing is for sure with the average Ugandan woman giving birth to 8 children, we are not short of children, we already have over 60!! The one thing we are very short of is resources if you are able to help in any way. We need teaching materials, and simple things like crayons, pencils, books etc. Our dream is to train our children and youth in the ways of God and see them release the Kingdom of God in their generation.
